

Rules & Regulations

The below listed items cover State, Insurance, and Marina regulations. Please read them carefully. If you have any questions please ask and we will be happy to answer them.

Personal Watercraft:

Trailer PWC must park in the parking area designated for cars with trailers and regular launching and parking fees apply. Season passes may be purchased for \$85.00. ONLY THE BOAT TO BE DOCKED AT YOUR SLIP IS EXEMPT FROM LAUNCHING AND PARKING FEES.

***PROPER TIE UP PROCEDURES MUST BE OBTAINED FROM THE STORE AND
MUST BE ADHERED TO WITHOUT EXCEPTION.***

State and Insurance Regulations:

1. No swimming in marina areas.
2. All pets must be on a 6' leash, and always attended. They must be walked at the extreme south end of the parking lot. No pets in the store, please.
3. FUEL CANNOT BE TRANSFERRED TO YOUR BOAT AT THE DOCK. THIS IS FOR THE SAFETY AND PROTECTION OF ALL DOCKERS AND THEIR BOATS.

Dual or Multiple Ownership:

1. WE MUST BE NOTIFIED IF YOU HAVE A PARTNER!!!
2. If you need an extra pass there is an additional cost of \$10.00 for each extra pass. This pass will not include the five guest passes on your original pass.

Dock Slip Change:

If you would like to move to a different dock please indicate your top 3 preferences on the bottom of your dockage agreement. As always, the current docker will have the option to retain his spot for the 2011 season. After that, changes will be made on a first come, first serve basis, determined by the date your deposit is received. No changes will be made prior to November 15, 2009. You will receive notification of your dock assignment in February 2011.

Sale of Boats:

1. You may sell your boat at any time while your boat is docked here.
2. You may ***not*** post "For Sale" signs on the dock or on your boat while it is parked at the dock.
3. If the sale of your boat includes docking privileges for the remainder of the season, you must bring the new owner in to fill out the proper paperwork. You will also lose priority in slip selection should you purchase a new boat the following season.
4. If someone is coming out to look at your boat, you must accompany them. If you do not accompany them, they will be sent away. We do not allow non-dockers to wander the docks.
5. We have a sales staff available and will be happy to assist you in the sale of your boat if you so desire.
